II. NEW BUSINESS

A. Background on project and Turtle Lake's involvement in CDBG program:

In 2018, the Village of Turtle Lake was awarded a \$13,850 grant from the Community Development Block Grant-Planning (CDBG-PLNG) program. The award is to help fund the update to the Village's Comprehensive Plan. The CDBG-PLNG program is a federally-funded grant program, which is administered in Wisconsin by the state's Department of Administration (DOA).

As part of the federal requirements tied to the CDBG-PLNG grant, the Village must hold two public hearings. The first hearing was held in 2018 prior to the submission of the grant application. Today's meeting is the second public hearing, and its purpose is to review the project's performance and to invite the public's comments on activities that are underway.

B.

Review of project performance:

The project commenced in early 2019 after receipt of the CDBG award. The West Central Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission (WCWRPC) was hired to assist with the update of the Village's Comprehensive Plan.

Between January 2019 to February 2020, the Village Plan Commission conducted six plan update meetings that were publicly noticed and facilitated by WCWRPC staff. As part of this project, in 2019, local residents participated in a community action planning effort facilitated by Community Collaboration, under a sub-contract to WCWRPC. The ideas, concepts and recommendations of this citizen-led effort were considered by the Plan Commission and incorporated into the draft Comprehensive Plan update. The Plan Commission also considered and incorporated into the draft plan the results of a Turtle Lake Housing Study completed by WCWRPC in 2019. Village staff provided additional information and mapping data that have been incorporated into the draft plan, as well.
