REGULATION OF LENGTH OF LAWN & GRASSES

Per Wis. Stat. §66.0407 - Sec. 8-1-6

Lawns and grasses that exceed 12-inches are considered a nuisance. A five (5) day notice will be issued to owners/occupants who have failed to cut his/her lawn, grass, or weeds. Village Public Works staff will cut grass/weeds from subject's property and shall charge the expenses to the owner, occupant, or person in charge of the subject premises. If not paid in thirty (30) days, charges will be applied to the tax roll against said parcel of land.

DESTRUCTION OF NOXIOUS WEEDS

Per Wis. Stat. §66.0407 - Sec. 8-1-4

Persons are required by law to destroy all noxious weeds on lands in the Village in which he/she owns, occupies, or controls. A five (5) day notice will be issued to owners/occupants who have neglected to destroy any noxious weed. Failure to comply with the notice will cause Village Public Works staff to destroy all such weeds growing and the cost will be assessed as a tax upon the lands the weeds are located. Noxious weeds include any weed, grass, or similar plant growth, which, if allowed to pollinate, would cause or produce hay fever or cause a skin rash through contact with the skin.
